LANE CLOSURES FOR THE ARROYO PARKWAY UPGRADE PROJECT

Sunday, November 1, through Friday, November 6

Los Angeles – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close lanes of the northbound Pasadena Freeway (SR-110) between the Golden State Freeway (I-5) and Bridewell Street for construction work related to the \$17-million Arroyo Parkway Upgrade Project. Up to two lanes will be closed from 9 p.m. to 7 a.m.

This project involves replacing the existing metal beam and temporary barriers with decorative concrete barriers, adding a protective fence on top of side barriers, and installing historic reproduction lighting. The project will improve safety for motorists, reduce maintenance costs, improve the appearance of the historic highway, and reduce exposure of Caltrans maintenance workers to traffic. Anticipated completion is fall of 2011. The contractor is Cooper/Myers.
