## **DATES SET FOR SR-110 55-HOUR CLOSURES**

**PASADENA** -- The first 55-hour weekend closure related to the Arroyo Parkway Improvement Project is scheduled to begin at 10 p.m. Friday, July 9 until 5 a.m. Monday, July 12 on southbound State Route 110 from Glenarm Street to Orange Grove Avenue. The closures are necessary to construct the median barrier and to expedite the construction schedule.

The \$17 million project, from the Golden State Freeway (I-5) in Los Angeles to Glenarm Street in Pasadena, will replace the existing barriers with concrete median barriers and side barriers that mirror the stonework architecture seen throughout the surrounding communities. Historic reproduction lighting will also be installed.

Twenty 55-hour closures are scheduled during construction and will occur every other weekend until early 2011. Traffic control measures will be implemented and detours will be signed. Additional notification will be sent before each closure. The project is expected to complete in late 2011.

Project benefits include improved safety for motorists, reduced maintenance costs, and protection for Caltrans maintenance workers
