### HARBOR FREEWAY (I-110) RAMP CLOSURE

**LOS ANGELES-** The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will be removing debris, sediment and trash from the storm drain at the northbound I-110 9<sup>th</sup> Street off-ramp. Construction crews will be working from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. Monday through Friday leaving one lane open for traffic to exit the freeway. This project is expected to be completed by mid-August. Intermittent closures should be expected. Major delays are expected.

There will be no work between July 26 – July 30, 2014.

Detours will be posted for motorist convenience. Once completed, this project will enhance access to downtown Los Angeles. United Storm Water, Inc. is the contractor on this \$80 thousand project.
