HARBOR FREEWAY STATE ROUTE 110 (SR-110) CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-110 for construction. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. The following closure schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Nightly, Sunday, March 14 through Thursday, March 18 SR-110

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – All connectors from southbound SR-110 to east- and westbound Santa Monica Freeway (I-10).

NORTHBOUND

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes of northbound SR-110 between Washington Boulevard and 8th Street.
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 9th Street off-ramp.
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 11th Street on-ramp.

SOUTHBOUND

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – 11th Street on-ramp.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – 8th Street on-ramp.
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – All connectors from southbound SR-110 connectors to east- and westbound I-10.

I-10

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Westbound connector to northbound SR-110

The project will improve traffic flow, ease congestion and upgrade access to downtown Los Angeles. Completion of the project is estimated for Summer 2013. Flatiron West Inc., is the contractor on this \$125 million project. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
