HARBOR FREEWAY (SR-110) CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES- The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-110 for construction. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time.

Motorists are advised of the following:

- **Westbound 3rd & 4th Street off-ramps will permanently close.**
- **Eastbound 3rd & 4th Street off-ramps remain OPEN.**
- **Use distributor road only when exiting 3rd, 4th, 6th and 9th Streets.**

The following closure schedule will be in effect, weather permitting:

Nightly, Sunday, November 28 through Thursday, December 2

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – All connectors from southbound SR-110 to the east- and westbound Santa Monica Freeway (I-10).

NORTHBOUND SR-110

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Washington Boulevard to 8th Street.
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 9th Street off-ramp.
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – 11th Street on-ramp.

SOUTHBOUND SR-110

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – 11th Street on-ramp.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – 8th Street on-ramp.

EASTBOUND and WESTBOUND I-10

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – East- and westbound connectors to northbound SR-110

STREET CLOSURES

- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – East- and westbound Olympic Boulevard between Byram Street and Sunbury Street.
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – East- and westbound 9th Street between Golden Avenue and Georgia Street.

Sunday, November 28

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – East- and westbound Olympic Boulevard between Byram Street and Sunbury Street.
