Nightly Closures for I-5 Slab Replacement Project

Los Angeles — The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close the following lanes of the Golden State Freeway (I-5) and the Ronald Reagan Freeway (SR-118) as part of a \$10-million slab replacement project between the Foothill Freeway (I-210) and SR-118. Closures are subject to change.

Northbound Golden State Freeway (I-5) Closures

Sunday, May 16, through Friday, May 21

- Up to three lanes of I-5 between Paxton St. and I-405
TIME: 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound I-5 HOV lane between Paxton St. and San Fernando Mission Blvd.
TIME: 10 p.m. to 6 a.m.
- Northbound I-5 HOV lane between San Fernando Mission Blvd. and I-405
TIME: 11 p.m. to 6 a.m.

Westbound Ronald Reagan Freeway (SR-118) Closures

Sunday, May 16, through Friday, May 21

- Westbound SR-118 Connector to Northbound I-5
TIME: 7 p.m. to 6 a.m.

This \$10 million project will rehabilitate pavement in both directions of the project area, a total distance of nine miles (4.5 miles in each direction). Benefits include enhanced traffic flow through this segment of the freeway, a smoother ride for motorists, and extended pavement life. The project is scheduled to wrap up by the end of the year.
