Gorman Road On-Ramp to Southbound I-5 to Close for Two Weeks

WHAT: The Gorman Road on-ramp to southbound I-5 in north Los Angeles County will close Thursday, September 5, 2013, at 1 a.m. and reopen Friday, September 20, 2013, at 5 a.m.

TRAFFIC IMPACTS: Motorists will be unable to access southbound I-5 from Gorman Road during the closure. Suggested alternate on-ramp: Frazier Mountain Park Road. Motorists can also take Gorman Road to southbound SR-138 and connect to southbound I-5 from there.

REASON FOR LANE REDUCTION: Crews will be placing new concrete pavement as part of a project that is rehabilitating the lanes and outside shoulders I-5 in both directions from just south of the Vista Del Lago Road overcrossing to the Kern County Line, a distance of 15.4 miles.
