### Northbound I-5 Off-Ramp Closures in North Los Angeles County: Quail Lake Rd. and Frazier Mountain Park Rd.

**WHAT:** Temporary closure of northbound I-5 Quail Lake Road and Frazier Mountain Park Road off-ramps.

**WHEN:** Thursday, Oct. 31, at 11:59 p.m. to Friday, Nov. 1, at 11:59 p.m.

**WHY:** Paving operation.

**MOTORIST NOTIFICATION:** Detours will be posted. Electronic message signs on the freeway will alert motorists to the ramp closures well in advance.

**ALTERNATE RAMPS:** For the Quail Lake off-ramp, use Gorman Road. For the Frazier Mountain Park off-ramp, use Gorman Road or Lebec Road. Detours will be posted.

**ABOUT THE PROJECT:** This project is replacing slabs in both directions of I-5 between the Vista Del Lago Road overcrossing and the Kern County Line, a distance of 15.4 miles. This \$100.1 million project, which will be completed in mid-2015, will extend the life of the pavement, reduce maintenance costs and closures, and provide a smoother ride for motorists. The contractor is Griffith/Coffman Joint Venture of Brea, Calif.
