## **POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES**

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-60 between the Orange Freeway (SR-57) and Corona Freeway (SR-71) for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Detours will be posted. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

### **Wednesday, April 27**

#### **Westbound SR-60**

- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from SR-71 to Diamond Bar Boulevard
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Grand Avenue on- and off-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp
- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connector from southbound SR-57

### **Thursday, April 28**

#### **Westbound SR-60**

- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to four lanes from SR-71 to Diamond Bar Boulevard
- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Grand Avenue on- and off-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp

## **Saturday, April 30**

### **Westbound SR-60**

- 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to five lanes from Diamond Bar Boulevard to Grand Avenue
- 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Connector from southbound SR-57

SR-60 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Chumo Construction is the contractor on this \$32 million project which is expected to complete winter 2012.
