POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-60 between the Orange Freeway (SR-57) and Corona Freeway (SR-71) for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Detours will be posted. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

Tuesday, July 12

Southbound SR-60

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Diamond Bar Boulevard, SR-57 north to SR-71
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard off-ramp

Westbound SR-60

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Phillips Ranch Road to Reservoir Street

Wednesday, July 13 through Saturday, July 16

Westbound SR-60

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to two lanes from Diamond Bar Boulevard, SR-57 north to SR-71
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard off-ramp

Westbound SR-60

- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Reservoir Street to Phillips Ranch Road
- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Carpool lane from SR-71 to Diamond Bar Boulevard, SR-57 north
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Phillips Ranch Road, Garey Avenue and Grand Avenue on-ramps
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Connector to and from north- and southbound SR-71

Thursday, July 14 and Saturday, July 16

Westbound SR-60

- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connector from southbound SR-57

SAN BERNARDINO FREEWAY (I-10) LANE CLOSURES

Westbound SR-60

- 8 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Diamond Bar Boulevard to Diamond Bar Boulevard, SR-57 north

SR-60 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Chumo Construction is the contractor on this \$32 million project which is expected to complete winter 2012.
