POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-60 between the Orange Freeway (SR-57) and Corona Freeway (SR-71) for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Detours will be posted. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.

Monday, July 25 through Friday, July 30

Westbound SR-60

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – **HOV Lane** from Diamond Bar Boulevard, SR-57 north to SR-71
- 7 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Diamond Bar Boulevard to SR-57
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Grand Avenue off-ramp

Monday, July 25 through Saturday, July 31

- 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m. – **FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE** from SR-71 to Garey Avenue
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Grand Boulevard and Garey Avenue on- and off-ramps
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp

SR-60 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Chumo Construction is the contractor on this \$32 million project which is expected to complete winter 2012.
