## **POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES**

**LOS ANGELES** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-60 between the Orange Freeway (SR-57) and Corona Freeway (SR-71) for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Closures are as follows, weather permitting and subject to change:

### **Monday, August 22 through Sunday, August 28**

#### **Westbound SR-60**

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from Diamond Bar Boulevard to SR-57
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Old Brea Canyon Road off-ramp

### **Friday, August 27 through Sunday, August 28**

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Grand Boulevard and Garey Avenue on- and off-ramps

### **Monday, August 22 through Thursday, August 25**

#### **Eastbound SR-60**

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Diamond Bar Boulevard, SR-57 north to SR-71
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-and off-ramps

Detours will be posted.

SR-60 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Chumo Construction is the contractor on this \$32 million project which is expected to complete winter 2012. Caltrans advises motorists to **“Slow For The Cone Zone.”**
