POMONA FREEWAY (SR-60) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-60 between the Orange Freeway (SR-57) and Corona Freeway (SR-71) for pavement work. One lane will remain open to traffic at all times; no two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Closures are as follows and subject to change:

Monday, August 29 through Sunday, September 2 **Eastbound SR-60**

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Diamond Bar Boulevard to SR-57; to SR-71
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Phillip Ranch Road on- and off- ramps
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. –Garey Avenue on- and off-ramps
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Diamond Bar Boulevard on-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Reservoir Street on-ramp

Detours will be posted. SR-60 is a major thoroughfare serving commuters and large commercial vehicles. As a result of heavy use, the asphalt pavement has experienced extensive wear. New pavement will improve safety and mobility for motorists. Chumo Construction is the contractor on this \$32 million project which is expected to complete winter 2012. Caltrans advises motorists to “Slow For The Cone Zone.”
