CANCELLED IN ENTIRITY

SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (I-405) CLOSURES

GARDENA - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-405 between the Harbor Freeway (I-110) and the Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. The closures are as follows:

Northbound I-405

Nightly, Monday, June 23 through Wednesday, June 25

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from I-110 to El Segundo Boulevard

Nightly, Monday, June 23 and Wednesday, June 25

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramps

Nightly Tuesday, June 24 and Wednesday, June 25

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – North- and southbound I-110 connectors

Southbound I-405

Nightly, Monday, June 23 through Wednesday June 25

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from La Cienega Boulevard/El Cienega Boulevard to Redondo Beach Boulevard

Monday Night, June 23

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramps

Tuesday Night, June 24

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – La Cienega Boulevard/El Segundo Boulevard on- and off-ramps

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramps
