SAN DIEGO FREEWAY (I-405) CLOSURES

GARDENA - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of I-405 between the Harbor Freeway (I-110) and the Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. The closures are as follows:

Northbound I-405

Tuesday Night, June 10

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the carpool lane from the I-110 to Hawthorne Boulevard
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Artesia Boulevard/Redondo Beach Boulevard/Route 91 off-ramp
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramps

Wednesday Night, June 11

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Redondo Beach Boulevard to Hawthorne Boulevard
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramp

Southbound I-405

Wednesday Night, June 11

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes and the carpool lane from Inglewood Avenue to Redondo Beach Boulevard
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to three lanes from La Cienega Boulevard/El Segundo Boulevard to El Segundo Boulevard
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramps
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – El Segundo Boulevard off-ramp
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – La Cienega Boulevard/El Segundo Boulevard on-ramp

Thursday Night, June 12

- 9 p.m. to 7 a.m. – Up to four lanes and the HOV lane from El Segundo Boulevard to Redondo Beach Boulevard
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Hawthorne Boulevard on- and off-ramps

Northbound I-110

Tuesday Night, June 10

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – All I-110 connectors to the northbound I-405

Peterson Chase General Engineering Construction, Incorporated is the contractor on this \$850,000 pavement rehabilitation project which will extend the life of the freeway, and provide a smoother driving surface and a safer commute.
