## **FULL FREEWAY and CONNECTOR CLOSURE**

### **WESTBOUND RONALD REAGAN FREEWAY (STATE ROUTE 118) FROM I-405 TO WOODLEY AVENUE**

**GRANADA HILLS and MISSION HILLS** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close all westbound lanes on the Ronald Reagan Freeway (State Route 118) from the San Diego Freeway (I-405) separation to Woodley Avenue for a pavement construction project. The work involves pavement grinding and installing wire loop sensors in the pavement to transmit transportation data.

The closure schedule is as follows:

#### **Thursday night, October 30, 2008**

##### **Westbound State Route 118**

- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. - Full freeway closure from I-405 to Woodley Avenue.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – One lane plus the High Occupancy Vehicle lane will be closed from just east of I-405 to Porter Ranch Drive.

##### **Northbound and southbound I-405 Connectors to Westbound SR-118**

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. - Full closure of both connectors.

Detours will be posted. Caltrans advises motorists to '**Slow for the Cone Zone.**'
