Closures Scheduled for I-110 Project

Los Angeles - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a pavement project. One lane of traffic will remain open to motorists at all times. The following schedule of closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

Friday Night, January 9:

- 8 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Up to 4 lanes of north and southbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.
- 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. – Northbound I-110 connector to east- and westbound Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105).
- 2 a.m. to 5 a.m. – Northbound I-110 Rosecrans Avenue on- and off-ramps.

Saturday Night, January 10:

- 8 p.m. to noon - Up to 4 lanes of southbound I-110 between Century Boulevard and Redondo Beach Boulevard.
- 11 p.m. to 8 a.m. – Southbound I-110 connector to east- and westbound I-105.
- 3 a.m. to 6 a.m. – Southbound I-110 El Segundo Boulevard and Rosecrans Avenue on-ramps.

Nightly, Monday January 12 and Tuesday, January 13:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes of northbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes of southbound I-110 from Century Boulevard to El Segundo Boulevard.
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Northbound I-110 connector to east- and westbound I-105.
- 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. – Northbound I-110 Imperial Highway and Rosecrans Avenue on-ramps and El Segundo Boulevard and Rosecrans Avenue off-ramps.
