Closures Scheduled for I-110 Project

Los Angeles - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a pavement project. One lane of traffic will remain open to motorists at all times. The following schedule of closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

Friday Night, January 30:

- 8 p.m. to 10 a.m. – up to 4 lanes of southbound I-110 between Century Boulevard and Redondo Beach Boulevard.

Nightly, Monday, February 2 and Tuesday, February 3:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to 4 lanes of southbound I-110 between Century Boulevard and Redondo Beach Boulevard.

Nightly, Wednesday, February 4 and Thursday, February 5:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to 4 lanes of southbound I-110 between Century Boulevard and Redondo Beach Boulevard.
- 11 p.m. to 5 a.m. – southbound I-110 connectors to east- and westbound I-105.

J Mc Loughlin Engineering Company, Inc. is the contractor on this \$3.1 million project, which will include pavement and loop detector work. Anticipated completion is summer 2009. Caltrans reminds you to “**Slow For the Cone Zone.**”
