## Closures Scheduled for I-110 Project

**Los Angeles** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a pavement project. One lane of traffic will remain open to motorists at all times. The following schedule of closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

### **Monday Night, December 8, and Wednesday Night, December 10:**

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes northbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.

### **Tuesday Night, December 9 and Thursday Night, December 11:**

8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes north **and** southbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.

### **Friday Night, December 13:**

- 11 p.m. to 11 a.m. – Up to four lanes northbound I-110 from El Segundo Boulevard to Century Boulevard.
- 11 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Northbound I-110 El Segundo Boulevard on-ramp.

### **Sunday, December 14:**

- 1 a.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes southbound I-110 from I-105 on-ramp to I-105 off-ramp.
- 1 a.m. to 9 a.m. – southbound I-110 on-ramp at Imperial Highway.

J Mc Loughlin Engineering Company, Inc. is the contractor on this \$3.1 million project, which will include pavement and loop detector work. Anticipated completion is summer 2009. Caltrans reminds you to “**Slow For the Cone Zone.**”
