Closures Scheduled for I-110 Project

Los Angeles - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a pavement project. One lane of traffic will remain open to motorists at all times. The following schedule of closures will be in effect, weather permitting:

Nightly, Monday December 15 through Thursday December 19:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes northbound I-110 between Redondo Beach Boulevard and Century Boulevard.
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Northbound I-110 connectors to east- and westbound I-105.
- 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. – Northbound I-110 Rosecrans Avenue off-ramp.
- 1 a.m. to 4 a.m. – Northbound I-110 El Segundo Boulevard off-ramp.

Saturday Night, December 21:

- 8 p.m. to noon – Up to four lanes southbound I-110 from Century Boulevard to Rosecrans Avenue.
- 11 p.m. to 10 a.m. – southbound I-110 connectors to east- and westbound I-105.

J Mc Loughlin Engineering Company, Inc. is the contractor on this \$3.1 million project, which will include pavement and loop detector work. Anticipated completion is summer 2009. Caltrans reminds you to “**Slow For the Cone Zone.**”
