CORONA EXPRESSWAY (SR-71) RESTORATION LANE CLOSURES

POMONA - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of SR-71 between Old Pomona Road and the Los Angeles/San Bernardino County line for maintenance. No two consecutive ramps will be closed at the same time. Detours will be posted. Closures are as follows, weather permitting.
