## **FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE SCHEDULED ON I-405 IN CULVER CITY**

**CULVER CITY** – The San Diego Freeway (I-405) will be closed at various locations in the Culver City area from Saturday, March 19 to Sunday, March 20 in order to replace power lines over the freeway. The closures and times are as follows:

- From 11: 59 p.m., Saturday, March 19 to 9 a.m. Sunday, March 20, the southbound I-405 connector to the westbound Santa Monica Freeway (I-10);
- From 11 p.m. Saturday, March 19 to 9 a.m. Sunday, March 20, the southbound I-405 connector to westbound I-10;
- From 9 p.m. Saturday, March 19 to 11 a.m. Sunday, March 20, the National Boulevard on-ramp to southbound I-405;
- From 11 p.m. Saturday, March 19 to 11 a.m. Sunday, March 20, the Washington Boulevard on-ramp to southbound I-405;
- From 9 p.m. Saturday, March 19 to 11 a.m. Sunday, March 20, the northbound Jefferson Boulevard on-ramp to northbound I-405;
- From 2 a.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, March 20, northbound I-405 from Jefferson Boulevard to I-10;
- From 1 a.m. to 6 a.m. Sunday, March 20, I-405 from Venice Boulevard to the Marina Freeway (Route 90);
- From 7 p.m. Saturday, March 19 to 11 a.m. Sunday, March 20, the eastbound and westbound Route 90 connectors to northbound I-405.

Detour signs will be posted.

The closures are in connection to the \$167 million High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV) project on I-405 from Route 90 to I-10. The project is expected to complete fall 2007. It is an extension of the current HOV lane project on I-405 from the Century Freeway (Route 105) to Route 90, expected to complete in 2006.
