TERMINAL ISLAND FREEWAY (I-103) CLOSURES

LONG BEACH – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of Terminal Island Freeway (SR-103) as part of a project to upgrade drainage, curbs, sidewalks and landscaping. Some night closures will be required. Closures are subject to change.

NORTHBOUND

Daily, Monday, July 21 through Friday, July 25:

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – one lane from Anaheim Street (I Street) to Pacific Coast Highway.
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Anaheim Street (I Street) on-ramp.
- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – southbound Pacific Coast Highway on- and off-ramps.

Nightly, Monday, July 21 through Thursday, July 24:

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – one lane from Anaheim Street (I Street) to Pacific Coast Highway.
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Anaheim Street (I Street) on-ramp.
- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – southbound Pacific Coast Highway on- and off-ramps.

SOUTHBOUND

Daily, Monday, July 21 through Friday, July 25:

- 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. – Anaheim Street (I Street) on-ramp.

Nightly, Monday, July 21 through Thursday, July 24:

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Anaheim Street (I Street) on-ramp.

A detour will be provided for motorist's convenience. HighLand Construction, Inc. is the project contractor for this \$535 thousand project. Completion of the project is estimated for fall 2008.
