HARBOR FREEWAY CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a bridge repair project. At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. Closures are subject to change.

Southbound I-110

Sunday Night, May 17:

- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from Redondo Beach Boulevard to The Gardena Freeway (SR-91).
- 8 p.m. to 5 a.m. – southbound I-110 connector to SR-91.

Tuesday Night, May 19 and Wednesday, May 20:

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes from 92nd Street to 104th Street.

Northbound I-110

Monday Night, May 18:

- 9 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to 3 lanes from SR-91 to 165th Street.
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – east- and westbound SR-91 connectors to northbound I-110.

Thursday Night, May 21:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes from 104th Street to 92nd Street.

Signed detours will be posted. T & G Construction, Inc. is the contractor on this bridge project scheduled to complete summer 2009.
