HARBOR FREEWAY CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a bridge maintenance project. At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Closures are subject to change.

Northbound I-110

Nightly, Sunday, July 19 through Thursday, July 23:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to four lanes from Colden Avenue to 92nd Street.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – east- and westbound Glenn Anderson Freeway (I-105) connectors to northbound I-110.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Imperial Highway on-ramp.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Century Boulevard on-ramp.

Southbound I-110

Nightly, Sunday, July 19 through Thursday, July 23:

- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to four lanes from 92nd Street to Colden Avenue.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Century Boulevard off-ramp.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – eastbound Manchester on-ramp.

Signed detours will be posted. T & G Construction, Inc. is the contractor on this project scheduled to complete summer 2009.
