## **ARTESIA FREEWAY (SR-91) LANE AND RAMP CLOSURES**

**Los Angeles** - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Artesia/Gardena Freeway (SR-91) in the cities of Long Beach, Paramount and Norwalk as part of a bridge maintenance project. The following closure schedule will be in effect weather permitting:

### **Eastbound SR-91**

#### **Nightly, Monday, September 24 through Friday, September 28**

- 7 p.m. until 7 a.m. – Up to four lanes between Paramount Boulevard and the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605).
- 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Connector from the eastbound Artesia Freeway (SR-91) to San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605).
- 11 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Connector from the southbound San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605).
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Bellflower Boulevard on- and off-ramps.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Clark Avenue off-ramp.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Lakewood Boulevard on- and off-ramps.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Downey Avenue on- and off-ramps.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Paramount Boulevard on- and off-ramps.

### **Westbound SR-91**

#### **Nightly, Monday, September 24 through Friday, September 28**

- 6 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes between Pioneer Boulevard and the San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605).
- 7 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Connectors from the north and southbound San Gabriel River Freeway (I-605).
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Bellflower Boulevard on- and off-ramps.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Clark Avenue off-ramp.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Lakewood Boulevard on- and off-ramps.

- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Paramount Boulevard on- and off-ramps.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – Cherry Avenue on-ramp.
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. - Atlantic Avenue off-ramp.

Preventative maintenance is performed to minimize or delay the rehabilitation of bridges in the future. Estimated completion on this \$2.5 million project is Summer 2008. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
