HARBOR FREEWAY (I-110) CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a bridge repair project. At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. Closures are subject to change.

Southbound I-110

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes from Anaheim Street to Channel Street.

Nightly, Monday, May 11, through Thursday, May 14:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes at Florence Avenue.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – one lane at SR-47. 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to two lanes from Venice Boulevard to Washington Boulevard
