HARBOR FREEWAY (I-110) CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Harbor Freeway (I-110) as part of a bridge project. At least one lane will remain open to traffic in each direction at all times. Ramp closures will be staged so that no two consecutive ramps are closed at the same time. Closures are subject to change.

Southbound I-110

Nightly, Sunday, August 17 through Thursday, August 21:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes from Anaheim Street to Channel Street.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to two lanes from Venice Boulevard to Washington Boulevard.

Nightly, Sunday, August 17 through Wednesday, August 20:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes at Century Boulevard.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – one lane at SR-47.

Thursday Night, August 21:

- 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. – up to three lanes at Century Boulevard.
- 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. – one lane at SR-47.

Northbound I-110

Nightly, Sunday, August 17, through Thursday, August 21:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes from Channel to Anaheim Street.
- 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to two lanes at Washington Boulevard to Venice Boulevard.

Nightly, Sunday, August 17, through Wednesday, August 20:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to three lanes at Century Boulevard.
- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – one lane at SR-47.

Thursday Night, August 21:

- 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. – up to three lanes at Century Boulevard.
- 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. – one lane at SR-47.
