HOLLYWOOD FREEWAY (US 101) CLOSURES

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Hollywood Freeway (US 101) between Los Angeles Street and Highland Avenue as part of a pavement rehabilitation project. The following schedule will be in effect.

Nightly, Friday, November 7, Sunday, November 9, and Tuesday November 11 Northbound US 101

- 10 p.m. to 7 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Alameda Street to Highland Avenue

Nightly, Friday, November 7 and Sunday, November 9 Southbound US 101

- 10 p.m. to 8 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Highland Avenue to Santa Monica Boulevard

Sunday, November 9 Northbound US 101

- 1 a.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Rampart Street to Silver Lake Boulevard

Southbound US 101

- 2 a.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes from Santa Monica Boulevard to Benton Way

Tuesday, Night, November 11

Northbound SR-110

- 11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. – Connector to northbound US 101

Wednesday, November 12

Southbound SR-110

- 1 a.m. to 6 a.m. – Connector to northbound US 101

All American Asphalt is the contractor on this \$500,000 project which will extend the life of the freeway, provide a smoother driving surface and a safer commute. Estimated completion is late winter 2008. Caltrans advises motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
