CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), to replacement of damaged Portland Cement concrete (PCC) slabs with Rapid Strength Concrete (RSC) slabs. The closures are as follows:

Saturday, Night, October 11:

- 10 p.m. to 9 a.m. – Up to three lanes northbound from Alameda Avenue to Sunland Boulevard
- 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Hollywood Way on- and off-ramp
- 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. – Roscoe Boulevard off-ramp

This \$531 thousand project will replace damaged cement slab and increase public safety. The contractor on this project is Peterson Chase Constructors, Inc. The estimated completion date is spring 2009. Caltrans reminds motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
