CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), to replacement of damaged Portland Cement concrete (PCC) slabs with Rapid Strength Concrete (RSC) slabs. The closures are as follows:

NORTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Tuesday, November 18 through Friday, November 21:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes northbound from Alameda Avenue to SR-170
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – East- and westbound Alameda Boulevard on-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Olive Street on and off-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Burbank Boulevard off-ramp
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Hollywood Way on and off-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Roscoe Boulevard off-ramp

SOUTHBOUND I-5

Nightly, Tuesday, November 18 through Friday, November 21:

- 7 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Up to four lanes southbound from SR-170 to Verdugo Road
- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – East- and westbound Alameda Boulevard on-ramps
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Sunland Boulevard on and off-ramps
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – Roscoe Boulevard off-ramp

This \$531 thousand project will replace damaged cement slab for a smoother ride and increase public safety. The contractor on this project is Peterson Chase Constructors, Inc. The estimated completion date is spring 2009. Caltrans reminds motorists to “**Slow For The Cone Zone.**”
