CLOSURES THIS WEEK ON I-5 BETWEEN I-605 AND I-710

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close various lanes on both directions of the Santa Ana Freeway (Interstate 5) between the San Gabriel River Freeway (Interstate 605) and the Long Beach Freeway (Interstate 710) **nightly** for sawcutting and replacing concrete slabs from Wednesday, January 7 through Sunday morning, January 11.

Wednesday night (1/07/15) - Northbound I-5, I-605 to I-710 (Operation: Sawcutting slabs)

11 p.m. to 5 a.m. - two lanes closed.
1 a.m. to 4 a.m. - three of four lanes closed.

Ramps Closed: Northbound I-5 Lakewood Boulevard on-ramps and Paramount Boulevard on-ramp.

Thursday night (1/08/15) - Southbound I-5, I-710 to I-605 (Operation: Sawcutting slabs)

11 p.m. to 5 a.m. - two lanes closed.
1 a.m. to 4 a.m. - three of four lanes closed.

Friday night (1/09/15) to Saturday morning (1/10/15) - Northbound I-5, Lakewood Boulevard to Triggs Street (Operation: Replacing slabs)

1 a.m. to 5 a.m. - three of four lanes closed.
5 a.m. to 7 a.m. - two of four lanes closed.

Ramps Closed: Southbound I-5 Atlantic Boulevard off-ramp – 8 p.m. to 9 a.m.
Northbound I-5 - Southbound Lakewood Boulevard on-ramp, Northbound and Southbound Paramount Boulevard on-ramps and Garfield Avenue on-ramp;
Northbound Atlantic Boulevard on-ramp – 10 p.m. to 9:00 a.m.

Saturday night (1/10/15) to Sunday morning (1/11/15) - Southbound I-5, Triggs Street to Paramount Boulevard (Operation: Replacing slabs)

1 a.m. to 7 a.m. - three of four lanes closed.

7 a.m. to 9 a.m. - two of four lanes closed.

Ramps Closed: Southbound I-5 Slauson Avenue on-ramp and Triggs Street on-ramp – 10 p.m. to 9 a.m.

These closures are related to a \$10 million pavement preservation project on I-5 from Interstate 605 to the Long Beach Freeway (Interstate 710) which began in summer 2014 and will end in 2016. Security Paving is the contractor.
