NORTHBOUND I-5 ON- & OFF-RAMP CLOSURES I-5 Improvement Project – Vista Del Lago Road to Kern County Line July 2, 2013

Caltrans is rehabilitating the lanes and outside shoulders of the Golden State Freeway (I-5) in both directions from just south of the Vista Del Lago Road overcrossing to the Kern County Line, a distance of 15.4 miles.

As part of this project, the northbound I-5 Smokey Bear Road on- and off-ramps will be closed Monday, July 8, through Friday, July 26, 2013, while crews place new concrete pavement. **For the Smokey Bear Road on-ramp closure, motorists may access northbound I-5 at the Vista Del Lago Road on-ramp. For the Smokey Bear Road off-ramp closure, alternate off-ramps are Quail Lake Road and Gorman Post Road.** See dates at right.

You may hear construction noise during the closure, but it will not exceed levels allowed by state and federal regulations. You may also notice extra lighting and a temporary increase in traffic on local streets.
