I-710 Pavement Rehabilitation Project Full Freeway Closure

LOS ANGELES – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will implement the following **FULL FREEWAY** closure for the week beginning Sunday, July 14 in relation to a \$120 million pavement replacement project on the Long Beach Freeway (I-710) from the Los Angeles River Bridge to the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10):

- The southbound Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) between Triggs Street and Ditman Avenue **NIGHTLY**, from 11 p.m. Monday, July 15 to 6 a.m. Friday, July 20.

Detours will be in place.

The project is installing precast concrete panels as well as concrete slabs in various traffic lanes and locations upgrade the median barrier and construct maintenance pullouts along the route to enhance safety for maintenance crews.

Shimmick Construction is the contractor on the project, which will complete in late 2015. Work also will include widening shoulders and installing fiber optic lines for various traffic management technologies.

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
