COMMENT PERIOD EXTENDED ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS GOVERNING STATE ROUTE 710 PROPERTY SALES

LOS ANGELES—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has extended the written comment period on the proposed regulations governing the State Route 710 property sales in order to give the public more time to understand and comment on this complex process. The originally scheduled deadline was Thursday, July 31. The new deadline is 5 p.m. on Tuesday, September 2.

The proposed regulations will outline how surplus properties along the SR-710 corridor in Pasadena, South Pasadena and El Sereno will be sold pursuant to state law. Caltrans is requesting the public's input as it adopts regulations to sell surplus properties along the State Route 710 corridor.

Written comments must be received by Caltrans no later than 5 p.m. on September 2, 2014. These may be submitted by e-mail to Affordable_Sales_Program@dot.ca.gov; by fax to 916-654-6378; or by mail to:

Caltrans will also host another public hearing in El Sereno in August. Date, time and location will be posted in the near future.

Caltrans will submit final regulations to the Office of Administrative Law for approval later this fall.
