LAST CHANCE TO COMMENT ON PROPOSED REGULATIONS GOVERNING STATE ROUTE 710 PROPERTY SALES

LOS ANGELES—The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) is holding two workshops to take public comments as it develops regulations to sell surplus properties along the proposed State Route 710 corridor. These are the last opportunities to have input to the proposed regulations that outline how surplus properties along the SR-710 corridor in Pasadena, South Pasadena and El Sereno will be sold pursuant to state law.
