COMPLETION CEREMONY FOR BALDWIN PARK BOULEVARD BRIDGE PART OF I-10 HOV CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

WHAT: Completion ceremony for construction of the \$6.3 million Baldwin Park Boulevard Bridge, part of the I-10 High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane construction project.

WHEN: Monday, June 27, 10:30 a.m.

WHERE: Parking lot area of project construction site, next to the Baldwin Park Boulevard Bridge. 1201 Baldwin Park Boulevard, Baldwin Park, CA 91706

DIRECTIONS: Eastbound I-10, exit Baldwin Park Boulevard. Turn slight right onto Dalewood Street. Take the first right onto Baldwin Park Boulevard, destination will be on your right.
Westbound I-10, exit Baldwin Park Boulevard. Make a left onto Baldwin Park Boulevard, destination will be on your right.

Background: The newly completed \$6.3 million Baldwin Park Boulevard Bridge is part of the San Bernardino Freeway (I-10) High Occupancy Vehicle (HOV or carpool) lane construction project. The HOV project is adding four miles of carpool lanes on the San Bernardino Freeway from the San Gabriel Freeway (I-605) to Puente Avenue. The \$169 million project is funded with federal and state funds, including \$66 million from Proposition 1B, the 2006 voter-approved transportation bond.
