CLOSURES SCHEDULED IN MALIBU

MALIBU – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) announces the closure of one southbound lane of Pacific Coast Highway (SR-1), between Carbon Canyon Road and Pena Creek Road, Friday, September 16, between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for utility work by Southern California Edison Company.

One southbound lane of Pacific Coast Highway, between Pena Creek Road and Topanga Canyon Boulevard (SR-27) will be closed Wednesday, September 28, between 10 a.m. and 3 p.m. for utility work by Southern California Edison Company.

One northbound and one southbound lane of Pacific Coast Highway, between Heathercliff Road and Mulholland Highway will be closed, Sunday, September 25, between 5 a.m. and 1 p.m. for the bicycle race portion of a special event (The MESP, Inc. Elizabeth Glasser Pediatric Aids Foundation Triathlon). Caltrans suggests that commuters use alternate routes, such as the Ventura Freeway (US-101), as there could be up to a one-hour delay through this area.

Caltrans has issued encroachment permits for these events.
