CALTRANS CONTINUES INTERSTATE 5 PAVEMENT REHABILITATION PROJECT NEAR GRAPEVINE

Lebec – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) in cooperation with Security Paving Company are currently underway with a pavement rehabilitation project on northbound Interstate 5 in Kern County near the Los Angeles County line to the Grapevine Creek Bridge.

Lane closures are necessary to safely reconstruct and replace deteriorated concrete panels on the northbound I-5 outside travel lane and grind and resurface the three adjacent lanes with rubberized asphalt on the 10-mile segment of I-5.

LANE CLOSURES Week of November 30 – December 5:

- November 30th – December 5th from 6:30 a.m. to 5 p.m. – close the two northbound travel lanes at a time for two-mile lengths within a 10-mile segment of Interstate 5 from the Fraizer Mountain Park Road to the Grapevine undercrossing.

The \$15.5 million pavement rehabilitation project is anticipated to be complete in late December 2009.

Motorists will be alerted to freeway lane closures via construction signage and electronic message boards along I-5.

Caltrans thanks the motoring public for their patience as we work to upgrade this segment of the freeway system. Motorists are reminded to allow additional travel time and drive with extra care through construction areas. Please *slow the for cone zone*.

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
