Northbound Santa Ana Freeway (Interstate 5) Full Freeway Closures

Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) South Corridor Improvement Projects

Santa Fe Springs – Caltrans will fully close the northbound Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) from Valley View Avenue to Carmenita Road nightly on Monday, March 17 and Tuesday, March 18 from 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m.

Closed Ramps: 10 p.m. to 5 a.m.

- northbound I-5 on-ramps at Valley View Avenue and Alondra Boulevard.

Motorists travelling northbound I-5 will exit at Valley View Avenue and re-enter northbound I-5 at the Rosecrans Avenue on-ramp.

The closure's length is one-mile and includes all three northbound lanes. The work involves re-setting k-rail (concrete barriers), installing superstructure rebar and installing falsework, the wood structural support for the new Alondra Boulevard Bridge.

This construction work is weather-permitting and may be delayed due to inclement weather. The work is part of the \$1.6 billion Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) HOV Widening Projects to construct one carpool and one general purpose lane in each direction from the Los Angeles/Orange County line to Interstate 605.
