GOLDEN STATE FREEWAY (I-5) CLOSURES FOR PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT

LOS ANGELES COUNTY - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5) at various locations for pavement replacement and rehabilitation. One lane will be open at all times. Connectors and freeway ramps will also be closed. The closures are as follows:

Nightly, Tuesday, August 23 through Thursday, August 25:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Burbank: up to three lanes southbound I-5 from Burbank Boulevard to Hollywood Way.

Nightly, Monday August 29, through Thursday, September 1:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Los Angeles: up to three lanes northbound I-5 from Pasadena Avenue to I-110 connector.

Nightly, Monday September 5, through Thursday, September 8 and Monday, September 12, through Wednesday, September 14:

- 10 p.m. until 5 a.m. – Burbank: up to three lanes southbound I-5 from Burbank Boulevard to Hollywood Way.

Please note, the westbound SR-60 connector to northbound I-5, westbound I-10 connector to northbound I-5 as well as various on- and off-ramp in the project area will be closed intermittently. Commuters can expect delays and should consider alternate routes. This \$5.3 million improvement project is estimated for completion in spring 2006. Caltrans reminds motorists fines are doubled in work zones.
