LONG BEACH FREEWAY (I-710) LANE CLOSURES FOR PAVEMENT REPLACEMENT

LONG BEACH - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Long Beach Freeway (I-710) for pavement replacement from the San Diego freeway (I-405) to the just north of the Glen Anderson Freeway (I-105). One lane will remain open at all times. The following schedule of closures will be in effect:

THURSDAY JULY 21:

- 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. – up to three lanes northbound, from Imperial Highway to the L.A. River
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – east and westbound I-105 connector to northbound I-710
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – east and westbound on-ramps at Imperial Highway to northbound I-710
- 10 p.m. until 6 a.m. – northbound off-ramp at Imperial Highway
- 8 p.m. until 6 a.m. – east and westbound on-ramps at Imperial Highway to northbound I-710

FRIDAY, JULY 22:

- 11 p.m. until 9 a.m. – up to three lanes northbound, from Imperial Highway to the L.A. River
- 11 p.m. until 11 a.m. – east and westbound I-105 connector to northbound I-710
- 8 p.m. until 9 a.m. – east and westbound on-ramps at Imperial Highway to northbound I-710
- 10 p.m. until 9 a.m. – northbound off-ramp at Imperial Highway
- 8 p.m. until 9 a.m. – east and westbound on-ramps at Imperial Highway to northbound I-710

SATURDAY, JULY 23:

- 11 p.m. until 11 a.m. – up to three lanes northbound, from Imperial Highway to the L.A. River
- 9 p.m. until 11 a.m. – east and westbound I-105 connector to northbound I-710
- 8 p.m. until 11 a.m. – east and westbound on-ramps at Imperial Highway to northbound I-710
- 10 p.m. until 11 a.m. – northbound off-ramp at Imperial Highway
- 8 p.m. until 11 a.m. – east and westbound on-ramps at Imperial Highway to northbound I-710

The work is estimated to complete winter of 2005/06. Peterson Chase is the contractor on this \$3.6 million project. Caltrans reminds motorists fines are doubled in work zones.
