Route 126 Pavement Replacement Project FULL FREEWAY CLOSURE PLANNED

Ventura and Santa Paula – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of State Route 126 as part of a 13-mile pavement replacement project. The entire project extends from the Ventura Freeway (U.S. 101) to Hallock Drive. The following closures are weather permitting and subject to change:

Nightly, Sunday, February 5, through Thursday February 9:

- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – **full freeway closure** of eastbound Route 126 from Peck Road to Hallock Road
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – eastbound SR-126 on- and off-ramp at Peck Road
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – eastbound SR-126 on-ramp at Briggs Road
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – eastbound SR-126 on-ramp at Palm Avenue
- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – eastbound SR-126 on- and off-ramp at 10th Street

The \$10 million project involves replacing deteriorated concrete pavement slabs with rapid-setting, high-strength concrete on the freeway mainline, placing concrete overlay on various on-and off-ramps, sealing cracks, grinding the pavement and restriping. The project is estimated to complete by the end of 2006. When completed, the result will be a smoother riding surface that will last longer and require less maintenance. A signed detour for the full eastbound SR-126 closure will be posted for motorists convenience. Caltrans advises motorists to please, *SLOW FOR THE CONE ZONE*.
