Full I-5 South Closures Canceled at Rosecrans Avenue; Intermittent On-Ramp Closure for Equipment Positioning

Norwalk – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has cancelled the full freeway closure of southbound Interstate 5 at Rosecrans Avenue that was scheduled for Thursday, February 4 (11:59 p.m. to 5 a.m. Friday, February 5) and Saturday, February 6 (1 to 6 a.m.).

In lieu of the full Interstate 5 South closures, crews will close the southbound Interstate 5 Rosecrans Avenue on-ramp intermittently between 11 p.m. Friday, February 5 and 6 a.m. Saturday, February 6, to move construction equipment onto the freeway to set falsework beams for the Rosecrans Avenue undercrossing. The number three lane (far right outside lane) on southbound Interstate 5 may also be closed intermittently during this time.

Motorists are being advised via social media and electronic message signs.
