## San Diego Freeway (I-405) at Temple Avenue Bridge


### PROJECT UPDATE:

Caltrans demolished an 18 feet wide by 196 feet long section of the I-405 Bridge at Temple Avenue in Long Beach due to prolonged water damage caused by broken drainage pipes within the bridge structure. The replacement bridge girders/section is currently being constructed. The cost for this is \$2.5 million. Construction began in January 2014 and crews are working Monday through Friday 9 a.m.—3 p.m. and nightly from 9 p.m.—5 a.m. to complete this project by late 2014.

### BENEFITS:

The community will get an updated bridge built to current standard with enhanced safety and a smoother ride.
