Interstate 5 South Corridor Improvement Projects

Nightly Lane and Ramp Closures on Northbound I-5 between Valley View and Carmenita

La Mirada and Santa Fe Springs – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close up to two lanes on the northbound Santa Ana Freeway (I-5) between Valley View Avenue and Carmenita Road this week, nightly Monday through Friday, June 4 – 8, from 10 pm to 5 am. Also, the northbound I-5 Alondra Blvd on-ramp will be fully closed nightly from 10 pm to 6 am.

Southbound I-5 lanes and on-and off-ramps within these limits will be open.

One northbound mainline lane remains open to traffic at all times. Crews and construction equipment will set-up concrete barriers (K-rail) on the shoulder. The nightly closures are weather-permitting and are subject to cancellation.

The work is part of the \$110 million I-5 HOV Widening and Alondra Boulevard Bridge Project to construct one carpool and one general purpose lane in each direction, from North Fork Coyote Creek Bridge to Marquardt Avenue, reconstruct overcrossings at Alondra Boulevard and North Fork Coyote Creek, and realign and upgrade adjacent frontage roads. The contractor is C.C. Myers, Inc. of Anaheim, Ca.
