OVERNIGHT FULL FREEWAY CLOSURES **on Northbound & Southbound I-5 from Valley View to Alondra**

La Mirada and Santa Fe Springs – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will FULLY CLOSE the northbound and southbound Santa Ana Freeway (Interstate 5) between Valley View Avenue and the Carmenita Road on the following nights:

- **(1 night) Overnight, Wednesday, April 11: 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m.**
- **(4 nights) Overnight, Monday, April 16 through Thursday, April 19: 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m.**

Motorists will be detoured off from northbound I-5 at Valley View Avenue; and from southbound I-5 at Carmenita Road. Detours will be posted. Please *'Slow for the Cone Zone.'*



Crews and equipment will be at work in the center median between Valley View Avenue and the Alondra Boulevard Bridge. However, the full freeway closure extends from Valley View Avenue to Carmenita Road, including on-ramps onto the freeway system between these limits.

The overnight work involves placing concrete median barriers (K-rail) and re-striping the lanes as part of the \$110 million I-5 Widening and Alondra Boulevard Bridge Project. Caltrans is constructing one carpool lane and one general purpose lane in each direction from North Fork Coyote Creek Bridge to Marquardt Avenue, reconstructing the Alondra Boulevard and North Fork Coyote Creek overcrossings, and realigning and upgrading adjacent frontage roads. The contractor is C.C. Myers, Inc. of Anaheim, Ca.
