Overnight Lane Closures on Northbound I-5 in Santa Fe Springs

Interstate 5 South Corridor Improvement Projects

La Mirada and Santa Fe Springs – The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) has scheduled lane closures on northbound I-5 between Valley View Avenue and Alondra Boulevard overnight on Wednesday, July 25 from 11:59 p.m. to 4 a.m. (Thurs. 7/26) in time for the morning commute.

UP TO TWO LANES WILL BE CLOSED on northbound I-5 between Valley View Avenue and Alondra Boulevard. One freeway lane and all on-ramps and off-ramps will remain open at all times. The closures are weather-permitting and are subject to cancellation.

The work involves placing safety devices such as channelizers and pavement markers as part of the \$110 million I-5 HOV Widening and Alondra Boulevard Bridge Project.

The project will construct one carpool and one general purpose lane in each direction, from North Fork Coyote Creek Bridge to Marquardt Avenue, reconstruct overcrossings at Alondra Boulevard and North Fork Coyote Creek, and realign and upgrade adjacent frontage roads. The contractor is C.C. Myers, Inc. of Anaheim, Ca.

Please Slow for the Cone Zone. Motorists are reminded that the “**Move Over/Slow Down**” law went into effect January 1, 2010, stating that motorists must move over one lane, if safe to do so, or slow down when vehicles with flashing amber lights are active on the side of the road. The law is for the safety and protection of Caltrans road workers, law enforcement personnel, tow truck operators and emergency responders who are working roadside.
