CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. At least one lane in each direction will remain open to traffic at all times. The closures are as follows:

Northbound I-5

Friday, Night, March 16 and March 23:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to two lanes I-10 connector to SR-2

Southbound I-5

Nightly, Sunday, March 18 and Monday, March 19:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes southbound SR-110 connector to North Broadway

Monday, Night, March 19:

- 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. – up to three lanes from SR-110 connector to North Broadway
- 9 p.m. to 10:30 a.m. – North Broadway on-ramp

Wednesday, Night, March 21:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – all southbound SR-110 connectors to southbound I-5

Thursday, Night, March 22:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – all southbound SR-110 connectors to eastbound I-10
- 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. – southbound SR-110 connector to southbound I-5

Southbound SR-110

Monday, Night, March 19 and Thursday, March 22:

- 8 p.m. to 6 a.m. – all southbound SR-110 connector to southbound I-5

CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

Saturday, Night, March 24:

- 8 p.m. to 11 a.m. – all southbound SR-110 connector to southbound I-5

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
