CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

LOS ANGELES - The California Department of Transportation (Caltrans) will close portions of the Golden State Freeway (I-5), for pavement work. At least one lane in each direction will remain open to traffic at all times. The closures are as follows:

Southbound I-5

Nightly, Sunday, March 25 through Thursday, March 29:

- 10 p.m. to 5 a.m. – up to three lanes southbound SR-110 connector to North Broadway

Nightly, Friday, March 30 and Saturday, March 29:

- 9 p.m. to 10 a.m. – up to three lanes southbound SR-110 connector to North Broadway

Nightly, Wednesday, March 28 and Thursday, March 29:

- 9 p.m. to 10:30 a.m. – North Broadway on-ramp

Night, Saturday, March 31:

- 10 p.m. to 10 a.m. – up to three lanes southbound SR-110 connector to North Broadway

Northbound I-5

Night, Friday, March 30:

- 10 p.m. to 6 a.m. – up to two lanes I-10 connector to SR-2

Southbound SR-110

Saturday, March 31 To Sunday, April 1:

- 8 p.m. to 11 a.m. – all southbound SR-110 connector to southbound I-5

CLOSURES SCHEDULED FOR PORTIONS OF I-5 FREEWAY

The closures are in connection with the \$56 million pavement rehabilitation project on the I-5. FCI Constructors, Inc. is the contractor. Estimated completion date is winter 2010. This project will replace damaged cement slab and grind or overlay the existing pavement in order to provide additional skid resistance and increase public safety.
